This weekly process has been shown to increase sensitivity and empathy, reduce anxiety and acts of aggression at school and at home, and leads to better sleep and concentration. The process also helps to improve children's ability to learn through meta-cognition, improved oral language and feedback skills in a collaborative environment.
